

CULTURAL CONNECTIONS

April 14 th – 23 rd look to the skies to witness the Lyrid meteor shower. The meteor shower is caused by debris from a passing comet named Comet Thatcher that takes 415 years to go around the sun. You can expect to see 10 to 15 meteors per hour during a surge that can sometimes bring rates of 100 per hour. A few billion years ago a meteorite struck the Earth near Hardisty, Alberta. This 320lb meteorite is named Manitou Asinîy.



Manitou Asinîy is sacred among the Indigenous people, believed to be a gift from

Creator. It is believed that Manitou Asinîy is a living, sacred being and possesses healing powers and protects the buffalo herds. In 1866 it was removed by the Methodist

missionaries and transported to Pakan, Alberta.

the Royal Alberta Museum's
Syncrude Gallery of
Aboriginal Culture in Edmonton,
Alberta.

CULTURAL CONNECTIONS

On September 30, 2022, an agreement was signed between the Alberta Government and the First Nations people to return Manitou Asinîy back to his home. Currently we are awaiting the building of the Manitou Asinîy-Iniskim-Tsa Xani Interpretive and Healing Centre to return Manitou Asinîy near as they can to the original site. If you want to do more reading on Manitou Asinîy he goes by many names; the Creator Stone, Manitou Stone, awâsis kôhtakocihk kîsikohk (the child who fell from the sky,) the Iron Stone, the Iron Creek Meteorite, and the Shining Rock to name a few.





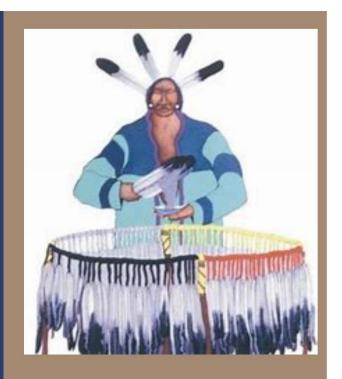
